

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prior to use, ensure that the drains are flowing and free from blockages. Simply place the tablet at the highest end, adjacent to the coil, away from the drain outlet, ensuring its in contact with the water. If it is a central drain, two tablets can be used if preferred, but only one is necessary to prevent biofilm in the drains.

The tablets should be replaced annually, cabinet stickers are issued with tablets to identify installation/replacement date.

BIOCIDE

Gel-clear tablets and formula are fully compliant with the EU Biocide directive, REACH compliant, Article 95 & 65 of the Biocidal Products Directive.

Gel-clear is for professional use only, always wear suitable PPE when working with condensate waste water.
